- Staff training for admin users on the content management system (CMS).

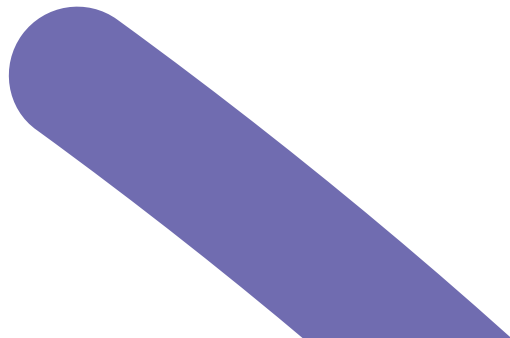
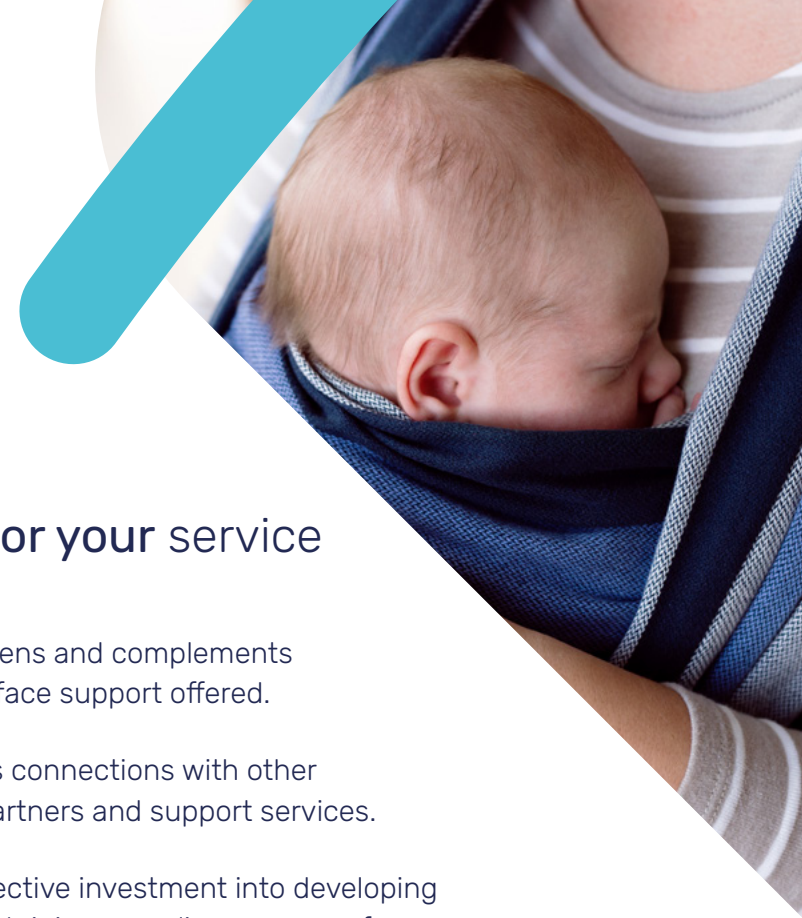
